Job Overview

Every morning at the International Village, a worship will take place for all international groups, where everybody is invited.

Responsibilities and Duties

Main duties for this position include but are not limited to:

1. Create a grid with a schedule and the name of the participants.
2. **Work with the General Conference Youth Department to coordinate the participation of Division Youth Directors from all over the world.**
 - a. They will present a brief report and worship every morning.
 - b. Ask them for a short video report.
3. Coordinate A/V volunteers for these international worships.
4. Invite different international groups to lead the music worship.
5. Invite international groups to assist and support their own Division leader.
6. Make sure that all equipment is available and ready.

Qualifications

- Love for God and Pathfinder Clubs.
- NAD member with a current background check approved by your Conference.
- Experience with Pathfinder Club practices and worship management.
- Friendly to different cultures.
- Master English language and ideally another language.

Schedule

- 1 year BTC: Meet with the team of volunteers and receive training.
- 1 year BTC: Confirm available international volunteers that want to be part of the morning worship at the International Village. Start contacting international groups that have already confirmed their attendance and invite them to participate.
- 1 year BTC: Work with the General Conference Youth Department appointed person, that will link Division Youth Directors with this activity.
- At the Camporee: Complete the program developed during the last year, and get in contact with all the participants.
- At the Camporee: Coordinate A/V volunteers, participants and Division Youth Directors.
