

On-Stage Host

The International Pathfinder Camporee On-Stage Host is responsible for hosting and representing the Main Stage for the Camporee. They will be responsible for introducing the Pathfinder Talent each night and transitioning between acts. They will also work alongside the Day-in-Review team to create the video each day.

Expected Dates and Hours

- Arrival Date - Friday prior to Camporee beginning
- Departure Date - Sunday after Camporee concludes

On-Stage Host Responsibilities

- Host is responsible for traveling to and from Camporee.
- Host is responsible to buy their own camporee volunteer ticket.
- Host is responsible to host and record the day in review video each day.
- Host is responsible to be the face of the Main Stage.
- Host is responsible for engaging the audience to the events taking place on the Main Stage as well as other announcements.

Camporee Responsibilities

- The International Camporee will provide your meals. You can eat breakfast in your hotel, or at the Camporee; lunch and dinner will be provided at the backstage cafeteria or the volunteer cafeteria.
- Camporee will provide a hotel room for the duration of your stay of 9 days - Friday PM – Sunday AM.
- Camporee will provide the host with \$250 thank you gift.
